ENTERPRISE TECHNOLOGY GOVERNANCE

It is the intent of the Department of Transportation to harness data and leverage technology to deliver products and services that improve safety, quality of life, and economic development in Florida.

A technology governance structure is established to effectively support the delivery of the Work Program, align technology and data, automate services, improve customer experiences, and bolster safety and connectivity on Florida roadways. This governance structure will:

- Create uniform data and technology standards;
- Enhance cybersecurity;
- Mitigate risks resulting from emerging technologies;
- Leverage assets to provide greater technological resources to Districts;
- Prioritize prospective technology projects that directly deliver the core mission of the Department; and
- Align IT/OT (Information Technology/Operational Technology) functions to best leverage resources and applications.

To implement this structure, an IT/OT Taskforce is created to develop recommended action plans and present them to the Chief of Transportation Technology, the Assistant Secretary of Intermodal Systems Development, Assistant Secretary of Engineering and Operations, and the Assistant Secretary of Finance and Administration for review and implementation.
